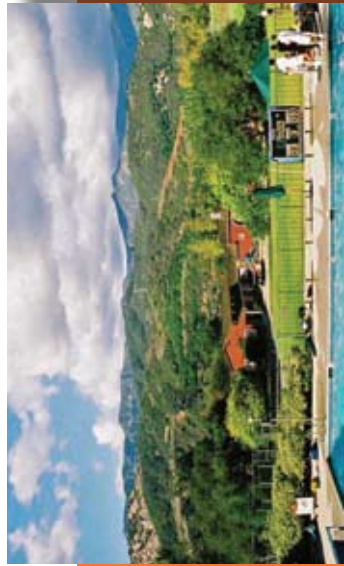

## STAFF

*Camp Haverim* knows that the success or failure of any camp rests squarely on the shoulders of its staff, counselors and supervisors, so we go to great lengths to get the very best. Itzik Ben-Sasson, will once more be Camp Director. Itzik has a broad range of experience directing an array of programs providing social and educational opportunities for our community and our children. Our senior counselors are predominantly college students from UCSB. Our counselors in training and junior counselors are local high school students with special skills and training. Many of our staff are themselves former campers. They care about our children, and it shows.

## CAMP SESSIONS 2008

Camp Schedule: There will be two (2) two-week sessions:

Session I: July 21st – August 1st  
 Session II: August 4th – August 15th

The camp day starts promptly at 9:00 am and ends at 3 pm. Remember, bus transportation is available.

## AGE OF CAMPERS

*Camp Haverim* which is non-denominational and inclusive, offers a rich experience to campers age 5 to 12, in grades K-6. Campers are grouped by age for most activities, but share other experiences as a group.

Our Habonim (which means the Builders) program is a separate program that offers more age-appropriate activities to campers in grades 7 and 8. Our Habonim will experience exciting sports activities, such as tennis, surfing and scuba diving, and receive leadership training to prepare them to return in subsequent years as CITs. As in the past, high school students will be able to participate as junior counselors

## ACTIVITIES

*Camp Haverim* offers many activities designed to meet our children's diverse interests and encourage learning and growth, such as Art, Music, Journalism, Drama, Maccabia Games, Swimming (with instruction available) and a full array of sports. Water activities, such as a slip-n-slide, will be available to children who do not wish to swim in the pool.

## TUITION

The cost of each camp session is \$450 for grades K-6. We offer children attending all four weeks a \$50 discount, reducing the total cost to \$850. We also offer a second child/sibling discount of \$50 per session. The tuition includes all camp field trips, a camp T-shirt and two snacks per day. There is an additional fee of \$100 for our 7th and 8th grade Habonim campers, to cover the cost of special activities.

**Early Bird Special! \$25 discount per session if enrolled by April 30**

**Scholarships are available for all age groups.**

## TRANSPORTATION

*Camp Haverim* offers bus transportation to and from camp with convenient pick-up points at San Marcos High School in Goleta and Pershing Park (at the corner of Castillo and Montecito streets) downtown. The bus, which costs \$60 per camper per two-week session, leaves Goleta promptly at 8:15 am and leaves downtown promptly at 8:45 am. At the end of our camp day, the bus returns to the downtown location at 3:30 pm and to the Goleta location at 3:45 pm. Bus service is available only to those who pay for it in advance.

## CAMP LOCATION

By popular demand, Summer Camp will once again be held at the spectacular, scenic & serene campus of Cate School! The campus is located on a 150-acre mesa between the Santa Ynez Mountains and the Pacific Ocean and is one of the most beautiful locations in Santa Barbara County. Cate School's grounds feature an athletic field, tennis courts, swimming pool, art studio and other recreational facilities.
